Rules

LFGA: Youth legal hunting age to 17 for the year of harvest. Adult - 18 and over.

Alberta Fish & Game Association along with the Lethbridge Fish & Game Association encourages anglers to release their fish and have adopted a record format for sportfishing based on length only.

All fish entered must include a picture of the entire fish, either on or beside a flat measuring device or in an open measuring tube that clearly shows the position of the fish relative to the measuring device including the end measurement. A second photo of the measuring device must also be submitted that shows the measurement scale including the start and end points. Measurements, if possible, should be taken based on the pinched tail

method as defined in the Alberta Guide to Sportfishing Regulations. Please minimize handling.

All entries must be legally taken by the entrant in the current sportfishing season as governed by the Alberta Sportfishing Regulations and all entries will be automatically entered in the AFGA Provincial Competition when eligible. Entries with a valid LFGA membership will be eligible for the LFGA Awards.

Winning entries will be notified and awarded at an appropriate time in the spring of each year. If qualified as an Alberta winner, you will receive a trophy and certificate for framing and will be a guest at the annual Awards Banquet to receive same. The trophy will be listed in the Alberta Wildlife Records Book and in the permanent records of the Alberta Fish & Game Association.
