

LFGA Upland & Migratory Bird Competition

2 Categories

Upland

- Pheasant: picture of entire bird placed beside a flat measuring device to clearly show the entire length from beak to tip of tail
- Merriam's Turkey: picture of beard clearly showing the start and end points against the measuring device
- Grouse - Blue, Ruffed, Sharptail, Spruce: must be weighed on a government certified scale
- Partridge: must be weighed on a government certified scale
- Ptarmigan: must be weighed on a government certified scale

Migratory

- Duck - Mallard: must be weighed on a government certified scale
- Goose - Canada, Snow, White-Fronted: must be weighed on a government certified scale

Rules

LFGA: Youth is legal hunting age to 17 for the year of harvest. Adult – 18 and over. AFGA: No age division

Download the "Official Bird Entry " form and follow the instructions exactly. You may take to Marksman Guns & Sports Ltd., 312 13 St. N. Lethbridge for measuring/weighing purposes.

All entries must be legally taken by the entrant in the current hunting season as governed by the Alberta Hunting Regulations and all entries will be automatically entered in the AFGA Provincial Competition when eligible. Entries with a valid LFGA membership will be eligible for the LFGA Awards.

Winning entries will be notified and awarded at an appropriate time in the spring of each year. If qualified as an Alberta winner, you will receive a trophy and certificate for framing and will be a guest at the annual Awards Banquet to receive same. The trophy will be listed in the Alberta Wildlife Records Book and in the permanent records of the Alberta Fish & Game Association.
