



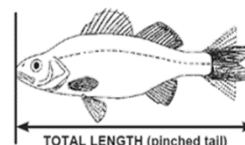
Alberta Provincial Wildlife Awards Official Sportfishing Entry Form

Effective January 01, 2018, all sportfishing entries for record purposes will be based on LENGTH ONLY.

Catch and release or size limits are common angling regulations put in place for fishery management purposes. The Alberta Wildlife Federation supports selective harvest of fish. Large fish are rare and an important genetic resource. Even when it is legal to retain, the Alberta Wildlife Federation encourages anglers to release these fish. For successful release, minimal handling is essential.

For these reasons the Alberta Wildlife Federation is adopting a record format for SPORTFISHING based on LENGTH ONLY.

*MUST include a picture of the entire fish, either on or beside a flat measuring device or in an open measuring tube that clearly shows the position of the fish relative to the measuring device including the end measurement. Photos(s) must show the measurement scale including the start and end points. Measurements should be taken based on the pinched tail method as defined in the Alberta Guide to Sportfishing Regulations. Please minimize handling.
